Plan to showcase your delegation's celebration of the Centennial at the International Parade of Nations which will march on State Street in the heart of Chicago. The parade will step off at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 1.

Plan to visit the Centennial Exhibit with special Lion artifacts and interactive experiences that will only be on display at the Centennial Convention. While the convention festivities take place downtown there will be tours to visit the Headquarters Office in Oakbrook. And new this year, the exhibit hall will feature a stage just for speakers on specific topics for the first ever "Lion's Campfire Sessions".
